Arrival at LodeStar

Please give your name to security informing them you are a volunteer, they will then direct you to Head Quarters (HQ). You will be introduced to your supervisor and managers for the duration of LodeStar. They will hand you your ID tag (do not lose this, if you do inform HQ immediately), Hi-Vis jacket and appropriate personal protection equipment (PPE) will brief you on the volunteer shift patterns, health and safety aspects and training of radio use, emergency procedures, site locations and show you the volunteer camping area to set up your tent or camper-van. Accommodation

Shift times

Shifts are usually rotated and in four hour blocks with Night shift 30 minutes shorter.

07:00 - 11:00	Early
11:00 - 15:00	Mid
15:00 - 19:00	Late
19:00 - 23:00	Evening
23:00 - 02:30	Night

Preparation

Please read & understand the **Stewards Manual** provided to you (this will be emailed to you prior to the festival)

If late, unable to do your shift, it is essential to inform your supervisor ASAP.

Swapping shifts with other volunteers must be agreed with your supervisor

Use your phone to alarm you and allow time to prepare yourself, check in with your supervisor in good time before your shift starts.

Alcohol

If you consume alcohol do so in your own time and allow a sufficient period of time to be clear of the alcohol influence before your next shift. If your supervisor feels you are under the influence of alcohol or drugs you may be asked to leave the festival.

Your Main Responsibilities - Please Remember Them

Always go to your supervisor to Sign in a the start of your shift and sign out at the end. Represent LodeStar in the best possible way at all times, a smile goes a long way :-) Be polite, helpful and presentable.

When on duty always wear supplied Hi-vis jackets and ID tags for recognition by security and festival-goers

Observe your surroundings for anything that may be dangerous and the general welfare of the the festival-goers, their demeanour or actions.

Be the 'eyes and ears' of LodeStar and report occurrences applicable and appropriate to your role as a volunteer, do not engage with anyone being aggressive, badly behaved or likely to cause offence to others - radio security with your location and description of person or incident

Any child that appears to be alone or upset, possibly lost please radio in, try to give comforting words, do not touch them unless they are in harms way, try not to be alone with them.

Help people in difficulty, provide information or directions requested or if your are unsure ask HQ on your radio

Please help to keep the site green and clean, it reduces litter as people are less likely to be the first to drop rubbish.
